
Jane and Evie's Used Bookstore Celebrates Two Years

Jane & Evie's, the Friends of the Oceanside Public Library's experiment at a storefront used-books store downtown, celebrated its second anniversary this spring.

The Friends also operate a used-book store in the Civic Center Library across the street (Coast Highway), but it isn't visible to passersby the way Jane & Evie's is on the busy main thoroughfare amid restaurants and other stores in a heavily trafficked commercial corridor.

Longtime Oceanside businessman and civic leader George Cheadle gave the Friends a good deal on the rent for the space and asked only that it be named for his late wife, Jane, and her friend, Evie





Magaña.

Both women had been active with the Friends and established book sales at the Mission Branch Library.

Jane Cheadle, who came to Oceanside in 1985 after a teaching career at Fullerton Junior College and California State University Fullerton, where she had helped set up a library foundation, did the same thing here.

Evie Magaña, a San Diego native, married into a pioneer Oceanside family and came here 68 years ago.

She still volunteers at the bookstore on the first and third Saturdays of the month. "I love to go there," she said in a

recent interview. "I meet so many people," she said.

Maggie Mula, who has managed the bookstore from the beginning, said it attracts both residents and tourists.

There are "regulars," she said, who come in frequently to buy the latest half-price sales items as well as visitors from the several hotels in the area. "A whole lot of people keep coming back," she said.

Mula's own background is not in libraries, but in retail sales.

And, of course, that's exactly what the bookstore is: a place of sales where some two dozen volunteers work hard.





In an interview, Mula reeled off all the categories of materials available from 1,000-piece jigsaw puzzles to DVDs, from volumes on the military to poetry, from books for toddlers to "really old" vintage books, from do-it-yourself crafts to graphic novels.
